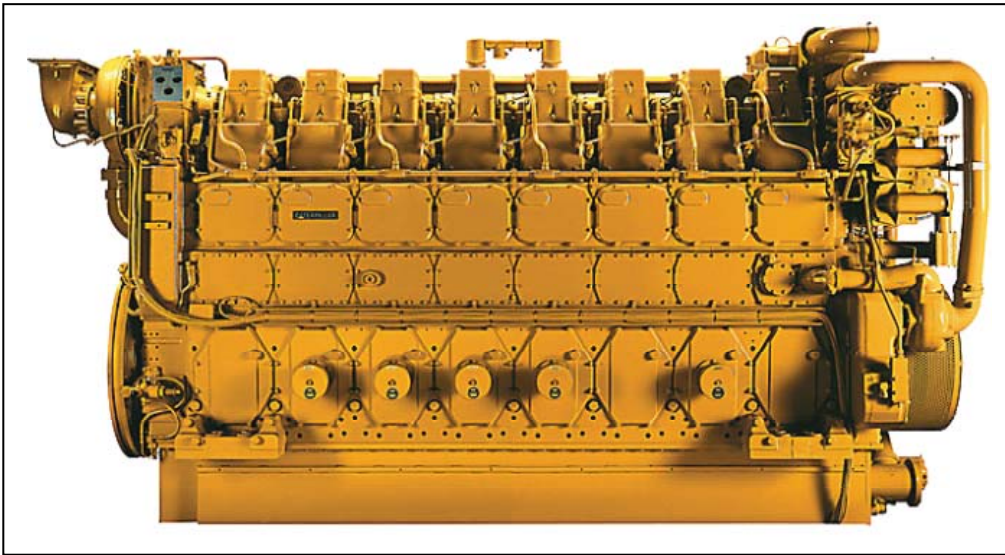

Empire receives Large Purchase Order

Sidney, BC: Empire Hydrogen has received a purchase order for 45-60 units to be delivered over 2018, with a cash deposit on the first ten units. The order was placed by Empire's Ontario distribution partner Canada Industria Corporation.



The first units will be installed on a 6,000 horsepower Caterpillar 3616 generator operating at a mine site in the North West Territories. This is a room-sized generator with 297L of engine displacement, nearly twenty times the size of a typical Class 8 truck engine. Because of its low RPM speed, we have calculated that 12 of Empire's Fuel Enhancement Systems, connected in series, will provide sufficient hydrogen/oxygen accelerant gases to give optimum fuel efficiency and emissions reductions. Because of the extremely high cost of transporting diesel fuel to these remote locations, this customer is particularly interested in achieving maximum fuel efficiency.

There are hundreds or thousands of similarly sized generators operating in small towns, at mines and oil camps across Canada's north. Empire's Fuel Enhancement System is a perfect immediate solution to a longstanding cost problem faced in all of these locations.

Under the Canada Industria purchase order, future Fuel Enhancement Systems will be installed on Class 8 and Class 6 trucks driving from Ontario and across Canada.
